

Jozsef Gal: Trends of Environmental Market of Central and Eastern Europe

With the dissertation, my aims are to examine the environmental market in Central and Eastern Europe and to compare it with the developed world. I make an attempt to support or disprove the following **hypotheses**:

1. In Central and Eastern Europe, the **generalized** connections of the environmental market cannot be considered as an evidence.

4. According to the known positive externalities of the environmental protection, the **judgment of environmental market** in Central and Eastern Europe is **favorably changed**, its dynamited effect is perceptible in the law, in the regional development, in the labour market and in other processes of innovation.
